Following successful completion of the course the student will be eligible to take the State of Indiana practical skills exam scheduled for July 14, 2012 at 8 am.

COURSE COSTS

Our EMT courses are competitively priced. The cost of the program is \$600. This includes, didactic and skill sessions, 32 hours of clinical experience, clinical polo shirt, stethoscope, safety goggles, and N95 particulate mask. We also provide the State of Indiana practical skills exam free of charge to those students successfully completing our program.

Payment for the course can be made using the enclosed remittance form and sending to: Elkhart General Hospital Financial Services, PO Box 1329, Elkhart IN 46515-1329.

Additional cost that the student will incur is the cost of the textbook that will need to be purchased by the student prior to the start of the program. There are many options available for the student to choose from including traditional hardcopy textbooks as well as other media choices .

Following successful completion of the program the student will be eligible to take the State of Indiana written exam (\$15 fee) or the national registry written exam (\$70 fee). At least one of these exams will be required for certification as an Indiana certified EMT. More information will be given to students during the program.

STUDENTS RESPONSIBILITY

The EMT course is an intensive six month program. Students will be responsible for studying outside of the classroom for successful completion. We will not cover all material in detail in lecture format in class. Our time will be better spent by applying the textbook concepts in a practical experience utilizing hands on simulation.
